

REQUIREMENTS AFTER ACCEPTANCE BUT PRIOR TO ATTENDING

- ❖ Provide evidence of negative Tuberculosis (PPD) test or chest X-ray results taken within one year prior to training commencement date, and which indicates tuberculosis clearance. Fomen Nursing Assistant Training Academy will keep a copy of the PPD or chest X-ray for its records.
- ❖ Provide Evidence of a physical examination taken within one year prior to training commencement.
- ❖ Provide evidence of Immunization record which must include Hepatitis B vaccination or declination information.

ENTRANCE/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- All applicants must be at least 18 years or older
- All applicants must complete and submit application form with the required application fee of \$25
- Provide evidence of having obtained a high school diploma or GED, or foreign equivalent. If no high school documentation is available, the applicant must achieve a passing score in the entrance examination.



FOMEN NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING ACADEMY (FNAA)

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The program prepares individuals seeking entry skills to begin a career in nursing as a nursing assistant.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The certified/Geriatric Nursing Assistant Training Program consists of 120 hours of instruction presented in two parts:

- Classroom/Theory-72 Hours of instruction in the theory and lab skills needed to develop nursing assistant skills, and
- Clinical Orientation-48 hours of clinical training in a local nursing facility, which enables the student to observe, develop, and utilize the skills learned in the classroom.

Upon successful completion of the training, the student becomes eligible for:

*Registration with the Maryland Board of Nursing as Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA)

*Sitting for the National Nurse's Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP) Examination (for students interested in nursing home employment as Geriatric Nursing Assistant, GNA)
